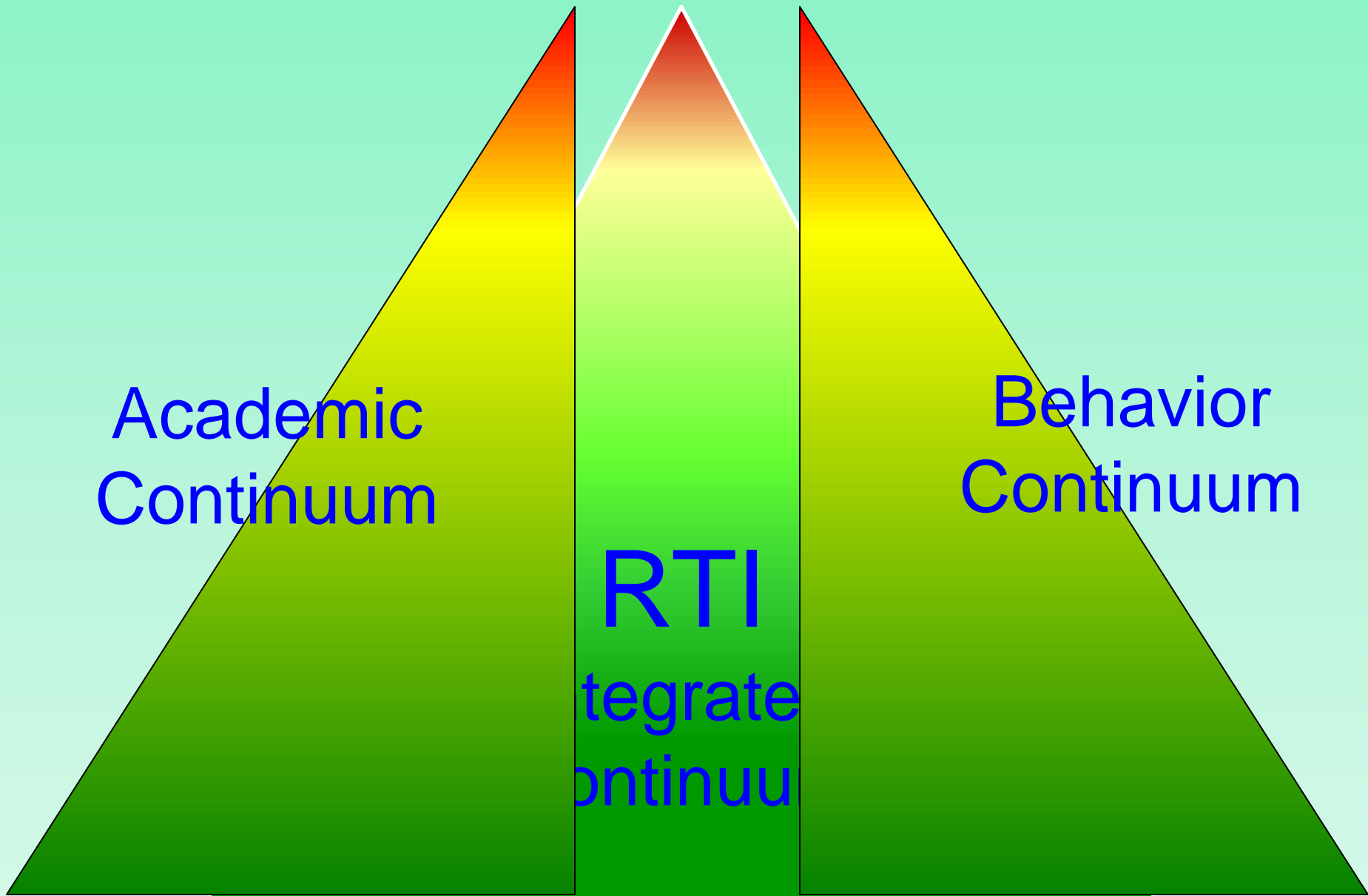

- RtI facilitators are not responsible for everything, teachers must actively participate in the problem solving process

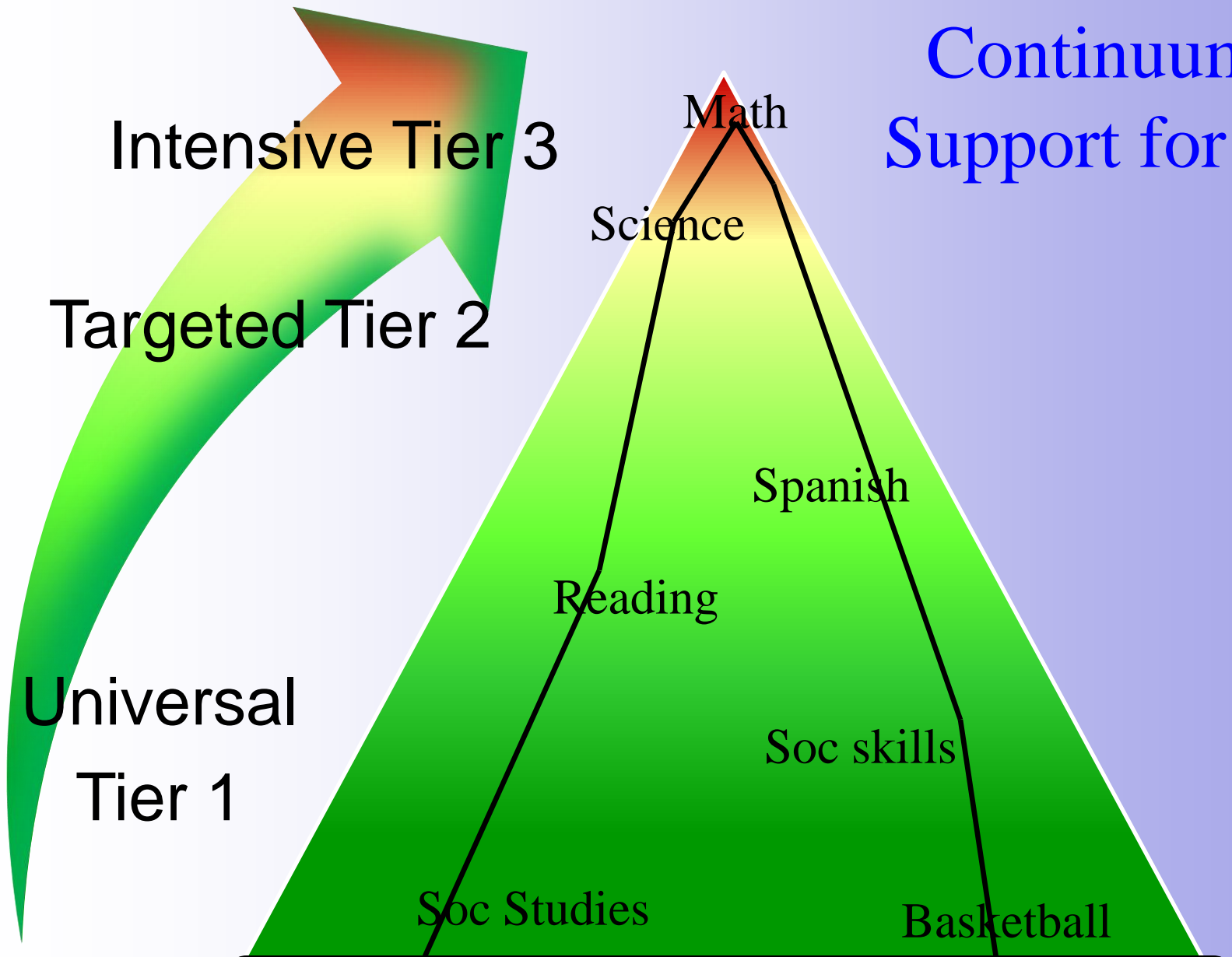
- **RtI facilitators may ask teachers to do something they have tried before but now collect specific data to track it**

Continuum of Support for ALL

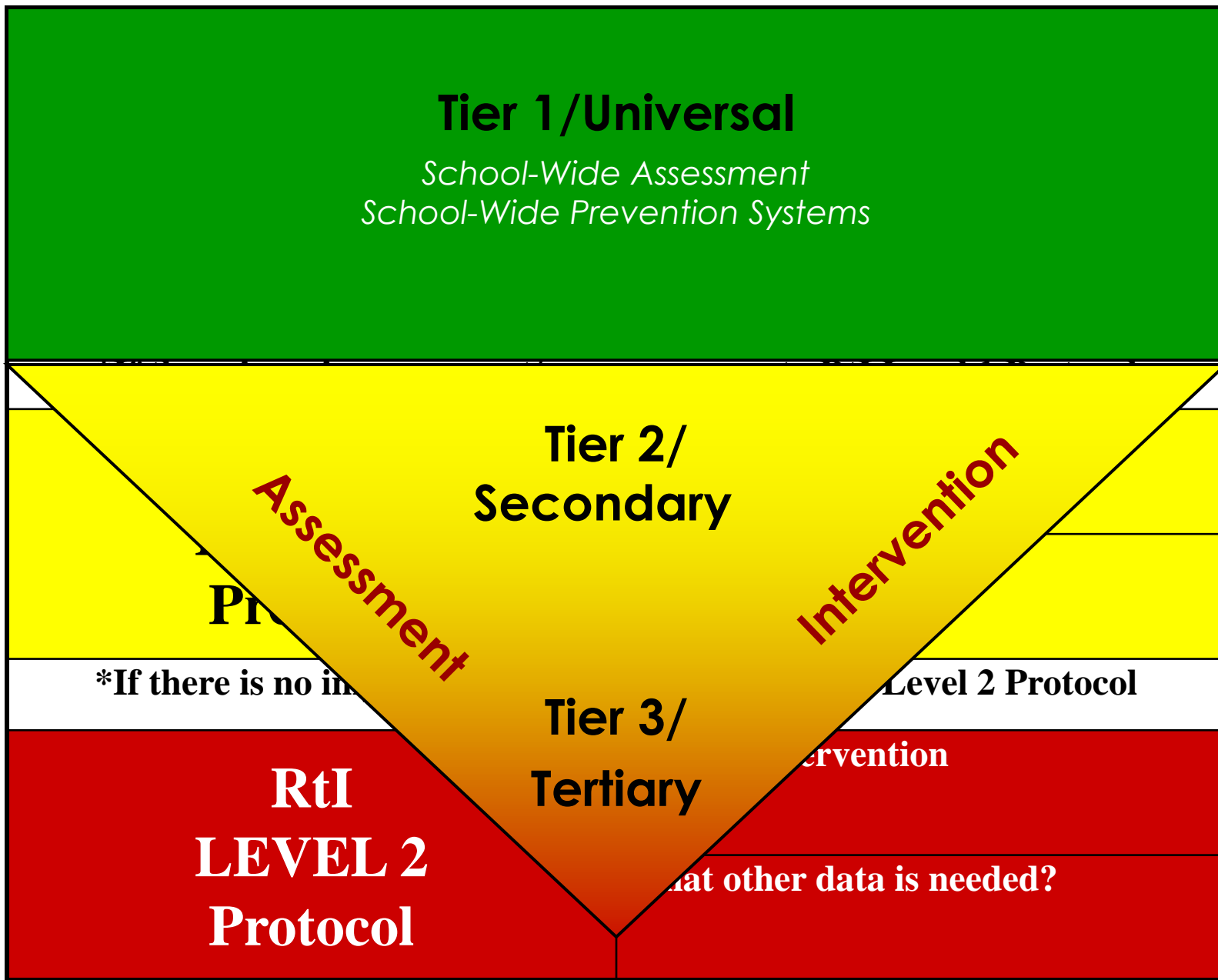

RtI PRE-LEVEL Protocol

Identify students (ongoing)

Prioritize students

Teams design and monitor pre-level interventions

- **R drive**
- **“On Team RtI Pre-Level Identification Log” Form 1**
 - Rate students to prioritize
 - If failed grade 7/8= Automatic RtI Level 1 Protocol
 - If IEP student=Refer to IEP Team
 - If 504 student=Refer to 504 Team first
- **“RtI Pre-Level Intervention Log” Form 2**
 - Top 3 students are considered each week
 - Students added on an ongoing basis
 - Adjust priority
 - Identify the target concern
 - Identify and monitor 1-3 Pre-Level Interventions to try for 3-6 weeks

RtI LEVEL 1 Protocol

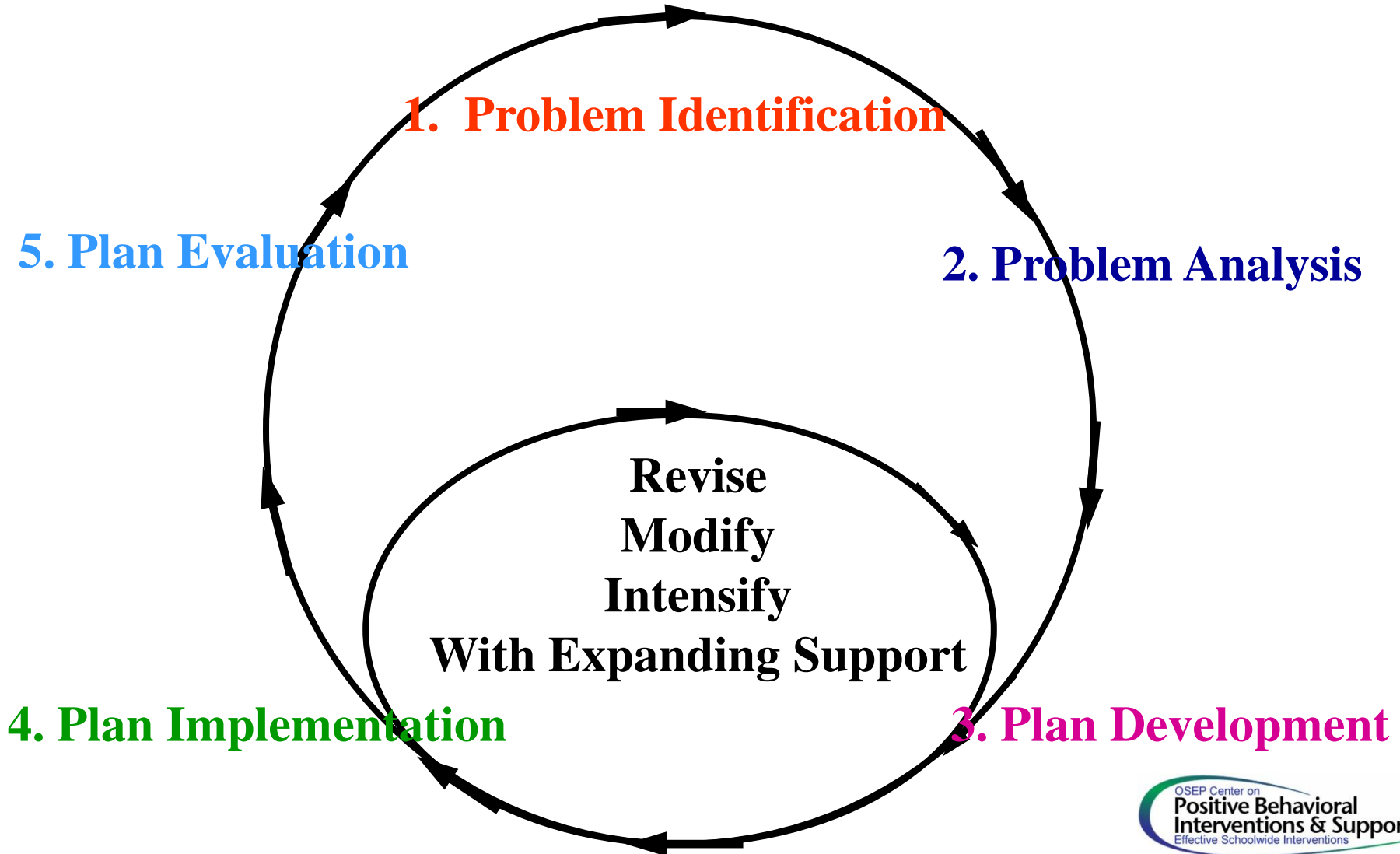
Request student history

Problem solving process

- **R Drive**
- **“Student History Form” Form 3**
 - Team requests Student History from Guidance
 - Team requests Student update on current level of support (Reading, Literacy, Numeracy, Behavior...)
 - Guidance will use Permanent Record/Test data to complete Form
 - Support (Reading, Literacy, Numeracy, Behavior...) will provide Guidance with current level of performance (Formative, CBM, SWIS...)
- **“RtI Level 1 Referral/ Intervention” Form 4**
 - Review student history, formative and summative assessments...
 - Develop a causation theory
 - Determine Intervention
 - Who is responsible?
 - Set Goal
 - Expected rate of progress?
 - Guidance will call Parents and send follow up letter
 - Monitor Progress
 - After 3-6 weeks: Was it successful?

Data Collection as a Foundation
