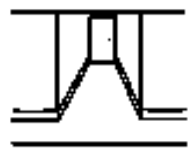

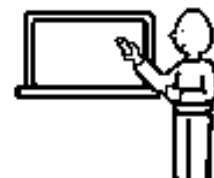

## Reliable

# Dress Code

- No halter, spaghetti strap, strapless, or backless tops. Shoulder straps must be at least the width of three fingers.
- No half-shirts which expose the midriff or muscle shirts.
- No spandex shorts or shorts that do not reach the ends of the middle finger when arms hang freely at the side.
- No short skirts that do not reach the ends of the middle finger when arms hang freely at the side.
- No pajama pants.

# Dress Code

- No undergarments should be exposed at any time. This includes boxer shorts.
- No hats and/or bandanas.
- Excessively tight or revealing clothing is not allowed.
- Decals, pins, buttons, that display profane language, drugs, alcohol, or promote violence, the use of illicit substances, or sexual activity are forbidden.
- Coats/jackets may not be worn during the school day.

# CAFETERIA EXPECTATIONS

- Clap - Signal to quiet students down
- Serving Order – Tables 1-5 (Left to Right) – Rotated by day of week
- Arrival Procedures – Students enter and follow wall to center of room or back wall. Proceed to homeroom table.
- Seating – Students sit at homeroom table.
- Lavatory – Students wait at doorway in line. One boy and one girl out at a time.
- Pass Back to Class – All students need a pass. Students arriving with a pass go directly to the lunch line to get lunch. Before leaving the cafeteria, student shows pass to administrator.

# CAFETERIA EXPECTATIONS

- **Vending Machine** – Students can go to the vending machines once the second table for the day is called. The administrator will announce when the vending machines are open.
- **Dismissal** is by front and rear table, beginning with the first table called for lunch. Students are directed to clean the table and the floor of debris.

# ATTENDANCE

## ■ ABSENCES

- Parent must call school
- Note must be brought in to HR teacher

## ■ TARDIES

- 5 tardies = written warning from administrator
- 6+ = detention

## ■ Early Dismissal

- Must have a note from home
- Submit to Main Office before Homeroom

## Consequences

1<sup>st</sup> Offense – Confiscated – get at end of day

# DISCIPLINARY CONSEQUENCES

- **TEACHER DETENTION** : 1 hour

- **SUSPENSION**: 1 - 10 days (Parent must reinstate you)
