Additional Information:

- Our season consists of 12 – 16 league games, additional non-league games may be added if weather and time permit
- Our home field is Foster Field
- Practices will be held every non-game day from 2:30 – 4:30pm, Monday through Friday
- There are **NO** minimum playing requirements during games, and there may be times that players will not see any game time. However, all players are actively involved in practices and working to improve their skills.
- Jerseys, shorts, pant, socks, and visor will be provided to each player. Players are responsible for maintaining and returning the jersey, shorts & pants at the end of the season. If any of the issued uniform is not returned OR damaged beyond normal wear and tear players are responsible for paying the damaged item.
